Failure to follow the direction of any official will be dealt with by the Clerk of Course, and can include exclusion, fines and/or licence suspension.

The Clerk of Course, may exclude from further competition, any Competitor who:

- After leaving the circuit, re-joins at a speed or in a manner considered dangerous to themselves, any other Competitor or to an official of the event;
- Exceeds 10 kph in the pit area;
- Drives in a manner considered dangerous to other Competitors, or in such a way that a faster car is prevented from passing;
- Is deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs (see Anti-Doping Policy below).
- Drives in an unsafe manner with a passenger on board.

### INFRINGEMENTS

All infringements are assessed on a case by case basis; the following is a guide only. It is to the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Steward to what penalty is applied.

The following infringements would be given as first warning as all competitors have already read Supplementary Regulations and would of attended drivers briefing.

Passing under yellow:

WRX members: 1 Competition point penalty.  
Non Members: Sit out 1 session.

Passing under Red flag / Ignoring Red Flag:

WRX members: 3 Competition point penalty.  
Non Members: Sit out 2 sessions.

Ignoring Black flag:

WRX members: 1 Competition point penalty.  
Non Members: Sit out 1 session.

Failure to follow directions from appointed official:

WRX members: 1 Competition point penalty.  
Non Members: Sit out 1 session.

Failure to attend drivers briefing:

WRX members: 1 Competition point penalty.  
Non Members: Sit out 1 session.

Driving in a manner inappropriate in accordance with venue policies and procedures:

All drivers: Sit out 1 session minimum up to Competition done for the day depending upon severity.

### Standard Track Procedures at IMPREZA WRX Club Events

Super Sprint vehicles whilst proceeding at track speed will require driver's window to be wound up except where window nets are in place. If the car is proceeding at a slow pace due to mechanical or other problems the driver may wind down the window and indicate to overtake. When being overtaken the responsibility is with the overtaking driver. The driver being overtaken should hold their line and not make any unnecessary change of direction

Drivers are expected to be familiar with the standard use of flags. It is the driver's responsibility to watch for applicable flags. Black and mechanical flags will always be displayed at start finish unless otherwise informed at driver briefing

### ENTRIES

Entry is only accepted via the online entry system at [WRX Club Motorsport web site](#)

- A completed 2019 Car Classification Form must be submitted if you have not already done so or made changes to your vehicle.  
**Note: This is not required if entering associate classes, or a public entry.**

Entries will be confirmed upon clearance of payment via email to the address used during online entry. The promoter reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the AASA NCRs.

<b>Max. Vehicles on circuit:</b>	20

**There shall be no refund/raincheck after 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019.**

No application for entry will be accepted on the day. No Cash payments for entries will be allowed on the day.

**ENTRY SCRUTINY**

All cars and drivers must attend and pass scrutiny prior to the event. At any time thereafter, any change to a vehicle, tyres or driver will need to be presented again for scrutiny before being allowed on the track.

**DRIVERS BRIEFING**

All competitors are to attend the compulsory drivers briefing in a nominated place on the day. Non-attendance, as evidenced by the roll call, could result in exclusion from the event and forfeiture of all fees.

**DRIVER ELIGIBILITY**

All drivers must hold a current AASA Club race license, or equivalent/higher.

**DRIVER AND PASSENGER APPAREL**

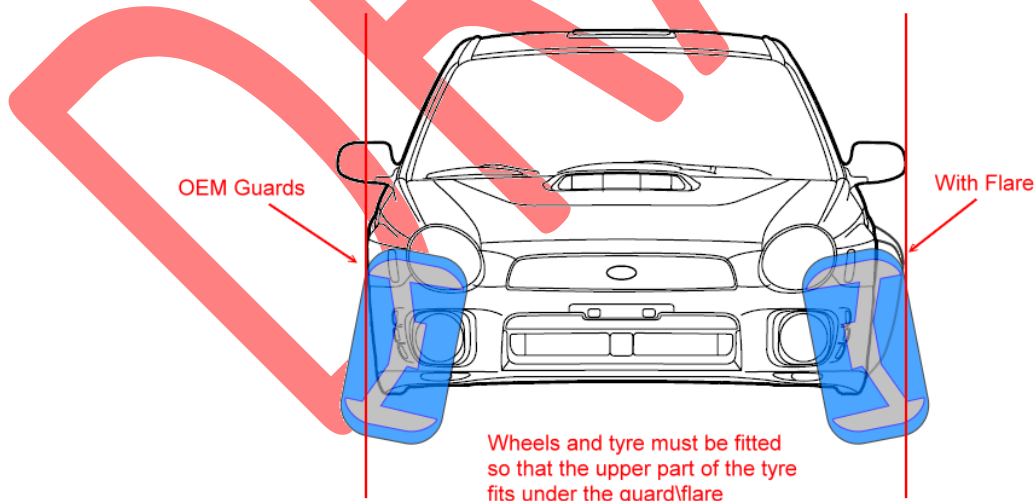
Drivers and Passengers must be attired in long legged trousers and long sleeved shirts or tops made of a non-flammable material. Footwear made of all leather or suede material is required.

Drivers and Trainers must wear a helmet to AS1698 or higher, in accordance with the AASA Standing Regulations.

**ENTRANT VEHICLE EQUIPMENT & SAFETY**

All vehicles must comply with AASA National Competition Rules and;

1. Must be fitted with seat belts to AS E35 or of a type compliant with AASA National Competition Rules.
2. Must be fitted with a fire extinguisher in accordance with the AASA National Competition Rules
3. All vehicles must use two separate fasteners on any forward opening panel (this includes OEM 2 stage release system)
4. Vehicles with the battery not in the engine bay shall display a blue triangle with sides of 150mm on the coachwork indicating the location of the battery (Blue car = Blue triangle with white border/edge.)
5. All forward facing glass except the windscreen shall be covered with clear adhesive film, or of a colour other than red.
6. Noise emission level is limited to 95dB (A) at 30 metres. Competitors who fail the drive-by 95dB reading will get 1 (one) chance to rectify the problem and will be excluded if the car fails on a second reading there will be no exceptions.
7. Fuel must be in accordance with AASA National Competition Rules. Refuelling must only be carried out in the designated areas.
8. All vehicles must have tow hooks fitted. Subaru WRX MY 01 onwards competitors must ensure that their tow hook is fitted to the front of the car prior to scrutiny.
9. All vehicles must have all loose objects removed from within all compartments of the vehicle
10. Vehicles are not eligible to run externally mounted cameras. Internal cameras or telemetry equipment must be securely mounted, and feature a secondary tether. Competitors must present this equipment at vehicle Scrutiny, and this equipment cannot be fitted after this time unless approved by the Chief Scrutineer.
11. Each wheel and tyre must be fitted so that the upper part of the tyre, down to the flange over the wheel hub centre must be within the perimeter of the automobile flare. See Drawing below;



**Any expense incurred by a competitor to the hired track or its equipment shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor.**

### CONDUCT OF THE EVENT

As noted in the schedule there will be up to 2 components of this event. Please note the following specific requirements of the following.

#### 1. Timed Sessions / Sprints

Timed sprint sessions will consist of a 10 minute session per group. The number of timed laps in this component may be varied at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Cars will be released onto the circuit one at a time with a suitable gap between each car

#### 2. Passengers in vehicle (TBA on the day)

Time permitting, passenger sessions may be conducted and will be announced during the day. These session(s) will be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course

Passengers are only allowed in untimed sessions that will be run separately to other sessions. They must have signed an Indemnity form, the Clerk of Course has full discretion when evaluating drivers with passengers and his decision is final.

Vehicles with passengers must run at 80% of the **driver and vehicle capacity of the times recorded on that day.**

If conducted, Passengers must be over 18 years of age and must sign the appropriate disclaimer. This is an untimed session at reduced speed. Cars from each group will be released onto the circuit one at a time. Overtaking can only occur on the straight sections of the circuit. In such circumstances the driver of the car being overtaken will signal to the overtaking car the side on which the overtaking manoeuvre should occur. The car being overtaken should maintain its line. The responsibility for the overtaking manoeuvre rests with the driver of the overtaking vehicle. Should a driver with a passenger on board leave the circuit during this session, the driver will be black-flagged and may be excluded from the event.

### CLASSES, TIMING, RESULTS

The Impreza WRX Club Motorsport Rules 2019 as published on their respective websites shall be binding. Entries will be classified according to Class eligibility.

Timing will be by means of a computer and the provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event via the club web site. Points will be awarded based on the fastest elapsed time for the day taken from the timed sessions. For timing, the Motorsport Director will be deemed the judge of fact for this event.

### PROTESTS

Any protest should be lodged with the Clerk of Course in accordance with the NCRs.

### ABANDONMENT & CANCELLATION

The promoters and the Clerk of Course reserve the right to abandon, postpone, temporarily suspend or cancel the event for any reason.

### ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

The consumption of alcohol or drugs by drivers, passengers and/or pit crew is forbidden whilst the event is in progress. Any person who, in the opinion of the Clerk of Course is in any way affected by drugs or alcohol may be excluded from the event and asked to leave the circuit.

### INSURANCE

All Competitors are covered against personal accident in accordance with conditions & benefits applicable as per the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Insurance Policy, details of which can be found at [www.aasa.com.au](http://www.aasa.com.au)
