CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Automotive Avenue Car Club Display (**Auto Ave**) is a display of special interest cars to be held at the Formula One event (as defined in the *Australian Grand Prix Act 1994* (Vic) (**Act**)) in 2018 (**Event**) at Albert Park (being the 'declared area' and 'designated access areas' as those terms are defined in the Act) (**Albert Park**). Auto Ave is organised by the promoter of the Event, the Australian Grand Prix Corporation (**AGPC**).

Applicants are invited to submit entries for their vehicles, including trailers, in Auto Ave by completing the Automotive Avenue Car Club Display Application Form (**Vehicle/s**). AGPC may at its discretion accept or reject any entries submitted. Applicants acknowledge and agree that if their application for entry is successful, they will be deemed to be an entrant in the Auto Ave (**Entrant**) and agree to be bound by and comply fully with the following conditions:

1. PROVISION OF VEHICLE AND COMPLIANCE WITH DIRECTIONS

- (a) The Entrant must comply with all directions of AGPC, in relation to the time, place and manner of delivery, location, display, movement and removal of the Vehicle and all other aspects (including promotion and advertising) of Auto Ave and the Event. Entrants must deliver their Vehicle to the Auto Ave area of Albert Park on Wednesday, 21 March 2018 between 0700 and 1900 (**Circuit**). Vehicles are to remain at Auto Ave for the entire Event. All such matters will be determined by AGPC at its discretion. AGPC reserves the right to disqualify Entrants that do not comply with its directions.
- (b) Each Entrant represents and warrants that, in respect of any photographs or other material provided to AGPC (**Work**), the Entrant has obtained all the necessary intellectual property rights, approvals, licences and clearances in order to authorise, and hereby authorises, AGPC or any third party nominated by AGPC, to use, copy and sub-licence the Work at AGPC's discretion.
- (c) AGPC may use an Entrant's image and name and any image or likeness of the Vehicle at its discretion in the promotion of the Event (including without limitation, uploading images and details of the Vehicle on AGPC's website for the purpose of facilitating a public vote on the winning Vehicle) and any other event organised by AGPC, without consultation of, or compensation to, the Entrant.

2. ENTRY AND CREDENTIALS

- (a) Each Entrant will receive two *guest passes* (subject to any conditions and restrictions determined by AGPC in its absolute discretion) to gain entry to the Circuit (**Guest Passes**). Entrants will not be permitted into the Circuit without a valid Guest Pass.
- (b) Each Entrant will also receive a *vehicle credential* (subject to any conditions and restrictions determined by AGPC in its discretion) to allow entry for a Vehicle to the Circuit (**Vehicle Credential**). Entrants will not be permitted entry into the Circuit without a valid Vehicle Credential.
- (c) Any Entrant wishing to bring a trailer to the Event must make this request to AGPC in writing at least 30 days prior to the Event and if AGPC approves this request, Entrant agrees to be bound by any additional conditions notified by AGPC.
- (d) Use of the Guest Pass and Vehicle Credential and entry to and presence at the Event is subject to:
 - i. the Attendance Conditions displayed at entrances to the Event and available at www.grandprix.com.au;
 - ii. any conditions attached to the Guest Pass and Vehicle Credential;
 - iii. the Act and any applicable regulations made thereunder;
 - iv. the Parks Victoria Code of Conduct for Contractors Undertaking Works at Albert Park (copy is available on request); and
 - v. all requirements of any authorities with jurisdiction over the activities of AGPC, Albert Park and any facility therein.
- (e) AGPC reserves the right to refuse entry to any holder of a Guest Pass or Vehicle Credential on reasonable grounds at its discretion.
- (f) Any Guest Pass and Vehicle Credential remains the property of AGPC at all times.
- (g) If requested by AGPC, Guest Pass holders must surrender the Guest Pass and/or Vehicle Credential and immediately leave Albert Park by the nearest exit.
- (h) AGPC may add to, alter or otherwise vary these conditions without notice.
- (i) AGPC may collect personal information about Entrants which is necessary for AGPC to operate Auto Ave and for the purposes of organising, promoting, marketing and conducting Auto Ave, the Event and subsequent Formula One events. A

copy of AGPC's Privacy Policy is available at www.grandprix.com.au and Entrants may gain access to their personal information held by contacting AGPC at PO Box 577, South Melbourne Victoria 3205. Entrants consent to the use and disclosure of their personal information by AGPC for the purposes of organising, promoting, marketing and conducting the Auto Ave, the Event and subsequent Formula One events, including sending the Entrant electronic messages such as email or SMS and telephoning the Entrant.

3. LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

- (a) The Entrant acknowledges and accepts that motor racing and activities related to the Event (including without limitation Auto Ave) are dangerous and accidents can happen. Entrants are warned that there is a possibility of an accident causing injury, death or property damage or loss and the presence of Entrants and their Vehicle(s) within the Circuit and participation in Auto Ave, and attendance at the Event is entirely at each Entrant's
- (b) To the extent permitted by law, the Entrant excludes, releases and forever discharges each of the Indemnitees from all liability for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, death, property damage, infringement of third party rights or otherwise) arising from or connected with the Event (including without limitation Auto Ave) and acknowledges that the Indemnitees or any of them will not be responsible for acts, omissions, or defaults of the Entrant or its personnel and will not be liable for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising from negligence, personal injury, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) arising from or in any way connected with any act, matter or thing done, or permitted or omitted to be done, by the Entrant or its personnel arising from or connected with the Event (including without limitation Auto Ave). The Entrant agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified the Indemnitees against any such claim, loss, damage, cost or expense including those relating to a breach of clause 1(b) by Entrant.
- (c) The Entrant acknowledges that entry of the Vehicle is at the Entrant's sole risk, and that AGPC accepts no liability for any damage which is sustained to the Vehicle however occurring.
- (d) The Entrant acknowledges that AGPC takes no responsibility for the Vehicle and any other property left at Auto Ave. The Entrant consents AGPC (or third party) to move without notice the Vehicle and property (if required) and the Entrant accepts no liability to AGPC or third party for any damage caused.
- (e) For the purposes of this clause **Indemnitees** means AGPC, the Crown in right of the State of Victoria, the Minister administering the Act, the Minister administering the *Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978 (Vic)*, the International Promoters, the Governing Bodies, the Other Event Organisers (Formula One Marketing Limited (FOM), Formula One World Championship Limited (FOWC), Formula One Asset Management Limited, Formula One Hospitality and Event Services Limited (UK), Formula One Licensing B.V., Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd, Allsport Management S.A., Parks Victoria, the State Sport Centres Trust, APP Corporation Pty Limited and all other persons involved in the conduct, promotion and organisation of the Event including officials, marshals, rescue and medical staff, the competitors and drivers (such parties to include where relevant all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors and affiliated companies) and their respective personnel.
- (f) Nothing in this clause 3 or these Conditions affects your rights under the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010 (Cth)*, *Australian Consumer Law and Fair Trading Act 2012 (Vic)* or similar legislation regarding implied conditions and warranties to the extent that such implied conditions or warranties cannot be excluded by law.

4. LICENCE, REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE

- (a) Any person who drives a Vehicle within Albert Park during the Event (**Event Period**) must hold a current Australian State or Territory driver's licence and must comply with all Albert Park road rules, including but not limited to driving on specified roads only and complying with speed limits. Any Vehicle or Entrant seen or found to have caused excessive damage (including but not limited to burnouts) to any surface of Albert Park will be liable for the cost of repairs to the surface.
- (b) All Vehicles must be currently registered and insured under any applicable compulsory insurance scheme in an Australian State or Territory
- (c) Entrants must obtain and maintain for the duration of the Event Period, at their own cost, a comprehensive vehicle insurance policy in respect of the Vehicle/s against any liability or loss incurred by the Indemnitees or any third party in relation to any act or omission by the Entrant or his/her agents or representatives or otherwise occurring in respect of the Vehicle, and covering damage to the Vehicle itself.
- (d) Entrants must provide evidence of such current driver's licence, registration and insurance policies to the satisfaction of AGPC on AGPC's request.

5. NO SIGNAGE

- (a) No signage or advertising is permitted on or in relation to any Vehicle without the prior written consent of AGPC (which may be withheld at AGPC's absolute discretion).
- (b) Entrants must not advertise, promote, distribute, sell or offer for sale any promotional material, merchandise or other goods or services within Albert Park or in relation to the Event.
- (c) Without limiting the effect of the foregoing, no signs or other references to tobacco or tobacco-related products may be displayed on or in relation to any Vehicle, facilities or equipment, and Entrants must comply with the *Tobacco Advertising*

Prohibition Act 1992 (Cth) and the Tobacco Act 1987 (Vic) and any other applicable tobacco legislation and regulations, notices and specifications issued thereunder.

6. TELEVISION, FILM AND MOVING PICTURE RIGHTS

Each Entrant acknowledges that:

- (a) Entrants will have no rights in respect of photographic images, television, film, video, digital imaging, radio, sound recording, or any other media or promotions dealing with or relating directly or indirectly to the Event (including the Display) taken, made, originated, created or recorded within the Venue during the Event Period or obtained or or acquired by Entrants at any time or in any manner (**Film Footage**) or any information or other data including official timing, results, performance, telemetry, weather or race control data (**Data**) of, at, or in relation to the Event, including photographic images and any still pictures derived or capable of being derived from a Recording (**Image**) and acknowledges that such rights vest with AGPC and/or FOWC and any assignee, nominee or licensee of AGPC and/or FOWC.
- (b) If an Entrant acquires any right, title or interest at any time in any of the Film Footage, Data or Image, he/she will not in any way use it and must immediately assign it to AGPC, FOM and/or FOWC and any assignee, nominee or licensee of AGPC and/or FOWC at no charge.
- (c) Entrants must not make, create, store, record, transmit, broadcast, reproduce or use (or authorise the making, creating, storing, recording, transmission, reproduction or use of) any form of Recording or Image, and must not store, record, transmit, reproduce or use any Data, of at or in relation to the Event (including of cars, drivers, teams, persons or activities present or situated within Albert Park) for any form of public advertisement, display, commercial gain or for any other purpose (except for the private enjoyment of the person making the Recording, Data or Image) except with the prior written permission of AGPC and/or FOWC in its (or their) absolute discretion.

7. SEVERANCE

Entrants acknowledge and agree that any of these Conditions which contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction will not be enforceable, however such Conditions (or part or parts thereof) are severable and do not invalidate the remaining Conditions.
